

## 19-21 July 2019 Entry Conditions

The Artist's signature on the completed Entry Form is confirmation that the Entry Conditions have been read and accepted by the exhibiting artist.

- 1. A completed Entry Form is to be submitted <u>by Friday 5 July 2019</u> indicating intent to exhibit by the original artist. Email form to <u>artatstmark0@gmail.com</u>, <u>or</u> post to St. Mark's, Grafton St., Warwick, Q4370 or drop into St. Mark's Church Office or into big RED BOX on driveway opposite Church.
- 2. Acceptance of any entry is subject to display space availability.
- 3. Acknowledgement of the receipt of an Entry Form will be made if an email address or mobile number is supplied. Enquiries may be made to Sue Nalder as per the contact details below.
- 4. **Up to <u>three (3) hanging artworks</u>** per Artist Exhibitor may be submitted. Each hanging artwork must not exceed 850mm x 650mm HxW or WxH INCLUDING any frame.
- 5. All works are to be delivered **DRY**, **prepared for hanging/installation** and be clearly marked on the back with the Artist's name, title of the work and the selling price. Works on paper or canvas **must** arrive framed (a stretched canvas is considered framed), fitted with D-rings **and** hanging wire. Works not correctly fitted will **not** be accepted.
- 6. There is **NO CHARGE** to enter **but ALL works must be for sale and will be subject to 25% commission,** used for Church maintenance and restoration, which will be deducted from any sale amount payable to an artist.
- 7. All exhibits are **to be delivered** to the Church Hall at Grafton Street on Tuesday 16 July 2019 between 8am and 1:30pm unless other arrangements have been made **before this date** with Sue.
- 8. All reasonable care will be taken in the control and handling of exhibits. Any existing damage evident on delivery will be noted on the Entry Form and may be photographed.
- 9. Artists are responsible for arranging any insurance cover desired. By signing the Entry Form, the Artist indemnifies the Anglican Parish of Warwick against any claim for loss or damage.
- 10. All unsold items **must be collected** on **Sunday 21 July between 3:30pm and 4:30pm** unless other arrangements are made **prior** to the commencement of the Show and **noted on the Entry Form**.
- 11. Artists must sign and provide details for an Authorised Person to collect either unsold art works and/or the cheque in payment (less the 25% commission) if they are unable to themselves.
- 12. Any expenses incurred to forward and return the works shall be borne by the Artist.
- 13. Payment will be made usually during the collection time of unsold items or within two (2) weeks of the close of the Art Show.
- 14. All works must be the original work of the Artist. If prints of originals are submitted for exhibition, they must be clearly marked as such.
- 15. The Artist agrees to a photographic and digital record of their work being held by and potentially used for future advertising of the event. Visitors will also be able to take photographs.
- 16. art@st.mark's reserves the right to withhold from display any item deemed unfit for exhibit.
- 17. An artist may submit a short bio (maximum of 200 words preferably as a *Word* document) which may be edited and advertised as available at the Sales Desk.
