After much deliberation, it is with heavy heart that the 2020 Management Committee for Warwick's iconic Jumpers and Jazz in July Festival wishes to officially convey the cancellation of this year's event.

In consideration of present and possibly ongoing community restrictions, which in turn would impact other events related to the festival, and the cancellation of other festivals both in Australia and New Zealand scheduled for later in the year, it has become imperative that we make a decision, and advise the public of our stance.

We are also in tandem with the Warwick Art Gallery's necessary decision to postpone the Tree Jumpers competition and Yarntopian Front Room installation – both integral components of the Jumpers and Jazz Festival.

The committee extends a warm invitation to Festival fans and newcomers to a fabulous 2021 event – hoping of course that the world by then will once again be free to celebrate as community!
